

Tasks

- 3 Inventory of actors, labs and major R&D projects related to the KBBE development in LAC.
- 4 SWOT analysis of the LAC natural resources as basis for KBBE developments.
- 5 SWOT analysis on the policy, regulatory and institutional capacities.
- 6 SWOT analysis of the technical and innovation KBBE like capacities.
- 7 Ex-ante assessment of the potential socioeconomic and environmental impacts of KBBE developments in LAC.

 - LAC; more 'disciplinary' based

- Meeting Antwerp, Belgium (Feb 2012)
 - Areas of potential synergies between ALCUE-KBBE and SAHYOG proposed, including inventories: ALCUE-KBBE focus on actors, labs & projects while SAGYOG on biomass
- Meeting Copenhagen, Denmark (March 2012)
 - Agreed to start working on common format between ALCUE-KBBE and SAHYOG,
 taking the FP7 Star-Colibri project database as the reference point
 - Within ALCUE-KBBE also agreed to adopt/adapt this approach for both LAC (T1.2)
 and EU inventories (T1.3)
